

How to Sanction your Poultry Show with the ABA

If you would like your show to be ABA sanctioned, please fill out the form below and send to abapoultryshows@gmail.com. If you would like your show to be considered as a District or State meet, please make the request to your district director and have them alert Hope of the change.

NOTE: You must agree to hire ABA judges for your show to judge all bantam classes.

Requirements: All judges at all ABA sanctioned meets must be members in good standing of the ABA. At District, State, or Provincial and Special Meets; a minimum of one judge must be ABA Licensed and not less than 50% of the judging staff must be ABA Licensed and all other judges must be APA Licensed or Canadian Provincial Licensed and must be ABA members in good standing.

A show report form will need to be submitted to the ABA within 90 days of your show. These can also be downloaded from our website. If your show does not submit a show report form, future sanctioning of your show may be withheld.

SANCTION REQUEST FORM

Effective January 1, 2019, there will no longer be annual dues collected for Clubs. All clubs who choose to sanction, will receive newsletters electronically. This will be covered with the sanction fees paid.

Each show held requires a \$50 sanction fee. This can be paid online or with the show report. Mail all fees and show reports to: ABA, PO Box 127, Augusta, NJ 07822
