Purpose: Unification with APA Standard ACCEPTED BY BOARD – FEB 2017

## **GOLDEN FEMALE PHOENIX**

HEAD: Golden.

NECK: Hackles – straw to light golden, with a narrow dark strip running down the center of the feather,

ending in a point near its extremity. Front of neck - rich deep salmon.

BACK: Grayish straw to brownish gray with straw shaft, stippled with deeper dark gray.

Coverts - same as back.

WINGS: Shoulders, Fronts, Bows and Coverts – same as back. Primaries – Upper web, dull black:

lower gray. Secondaries – Exposed portion, same as back: remaining feathers, black.

BREAST: Rich salmon, blending with the body color at sides.

BODY, STERN AND LOWER THIGHS: Ashy gray. Shanks and Toes - Leaden blue.

UNDERCOLOR: Ashy gray in all sections.
